



In 2009 Sokhumi State University won TEMPUS IV grant competition. Tempus is the European Union's program which supports the modernization of higher education in the Partner Countries of Eastern Europe, Central Asia, the Western Balkans and the Mediterranean region, mainly through university cooperation projects.

The name of the projects is "Higher Education System Development for Social Partnership Improvement and Humanity Sciences Competitiveness".

In the framework of the project the partners of Sokhumi State University (coordinator: Professor Indira Dzagania) from EU member countries are: universities of Latvia, Portugal and Italy; from the EU partner countries are Universities of Ukraine, Armenia and Moldova. Duration of the project is 3 years (2010-2013).
