

On February 23, 2010 the jubilee actions, dedicated to 95 anniversary of the famous Georgian Archaeologist - Andria Apakidze were held. The jubilee was conducted by the Academician of the National Academy of Sciences of Georgia Professor Tamaz Gamkrelidze.

Among the guests were the scientists from Sokhumi State University. The Rector of the University, Professor Joni Apakidze talked about A. Apakidze as of one of famous scientists and personalities. It was especially noted at the meeting that one of Tbilisi streets had been named after Andria Apakidze.

Before the meeting the memorial plate was hang on the house where A. Apakidze had lived and his grave at the Mtskheta Monastery was decorated with flowers.
